BYLAWS

Oregon Athletic Directors Association

As restated and filed May 20, 2012

Section 1 - Major Awards

Three major awards may be presented:

Athletic Director of the Year Distinguished Service Award (Non-member) NIAAA Award of Merit (Must be a NIAAA member)

- 1. With the exception of the Distinguished Service Award for non-members, all nominees must be members of the Association.
- 2. Names of nominees for awards shall be compiled by the Secretary and proper forms shall be sent to nominees by the Secretary.
- 3. Selection of award winners will be made by the Executive Committee.
- 4. An "Athletic Director of the Year" may be chosen in each of the six classifications, 6A, 5A, 4A, 3A, 2A, and IA. One from each (1A-3A and 4A-6A) "Athletic Directors of the Year" will be selected as "Oregon Athletic Director of the Year".
- 5. The name of the "Oregon Athletic Director of the Year" may be submitted to the NIAAA for recognition for the NIAAA Award of Merit awarded by that organization.
- 6. Each nominee for "Athletic Director of the Year" honors shall receive a certificate recognizing him/her as a nominee for this award.
- 7. All awards to members of the Association shall be presented at the OADA Conference. Awards to non-members of the Association will be presented at a site chosen by the school nominating the non-member for an award.

Section 2 - Retired Athletic Directors

- 1. Members of the League Representative Council shall submit to the Secretary the names of any athletic directors in their League/District who are retiring by the end of the school year. The Association will present retiring athletic directors with an appropriate plaque at the annual OADA Convention.
- 2. To qualify for this award, the Individual nominated must meet one of the following criteria:
- a. He/she must be an active member of the Association leaving the field of education by retirement or for employment outside of education.
- b. He/she must have been an active member for ten years and leaving the athletic director's position for another position within education.

Section 3 - OADA Scholarships

- 1. Graduating sons/daughters of Association members are eligible to apply. Deadline for application will be established by the Executive Committee. Forms are available on the OADA web site.
- 2. Two scholarships, up to \$500 each, will be awarded to a selected son/daughter of an Association member.
- 3. Scholarship nominees will be forwarded to an AD Hoc committee established by the Executive Committee.
- 4. The Scholarship Committee will select winner(s), and submit the results to the Executive Committee, based on criteria established by the Executive Committee.
- 5. The scholarships will be announced at the annual OADA Conference.

Section 4 – Expenses

A. National AD Conference

Expenses for the National Athletic Director Conference include: registration, air-fare, lodging, and a per diem for meals based at the GSA (General Services Administration) rate.

- 1. The Association President's expenses will be paid for in full.
- 2. The Association Executive Director's expenses will be paid in full.
- 3. The Association Vice-President or Designee's expenses will be ½ paid.
- 4. The Association NIAAA Executive Board Member's expenses will be paid in full when rotated.

B. Apparel

- 1. The Executive Board and Executive Committee will receive a shirt and an additional piece of clothing.
- 2. The League Representative Council will receive a shirt.

C. State Conference

- 1. The Executive Board may waive conference registration fees for Executive Committee members who accept responsibilities involving significant time commitment at the conference or in preparation for the conference.
- 2. The number of complimentary rooms/upgrades available to the Executive Committee will be set by the Executive Board each year based on contractual agreements, fiscal constraints and involvement in conference duties. Complimentary rooms/upgrades will be offered on a first right of refusal basis in the following order: Executive Director; Conference Chairman; Remaining Executive Board members; Classification Representatives.
